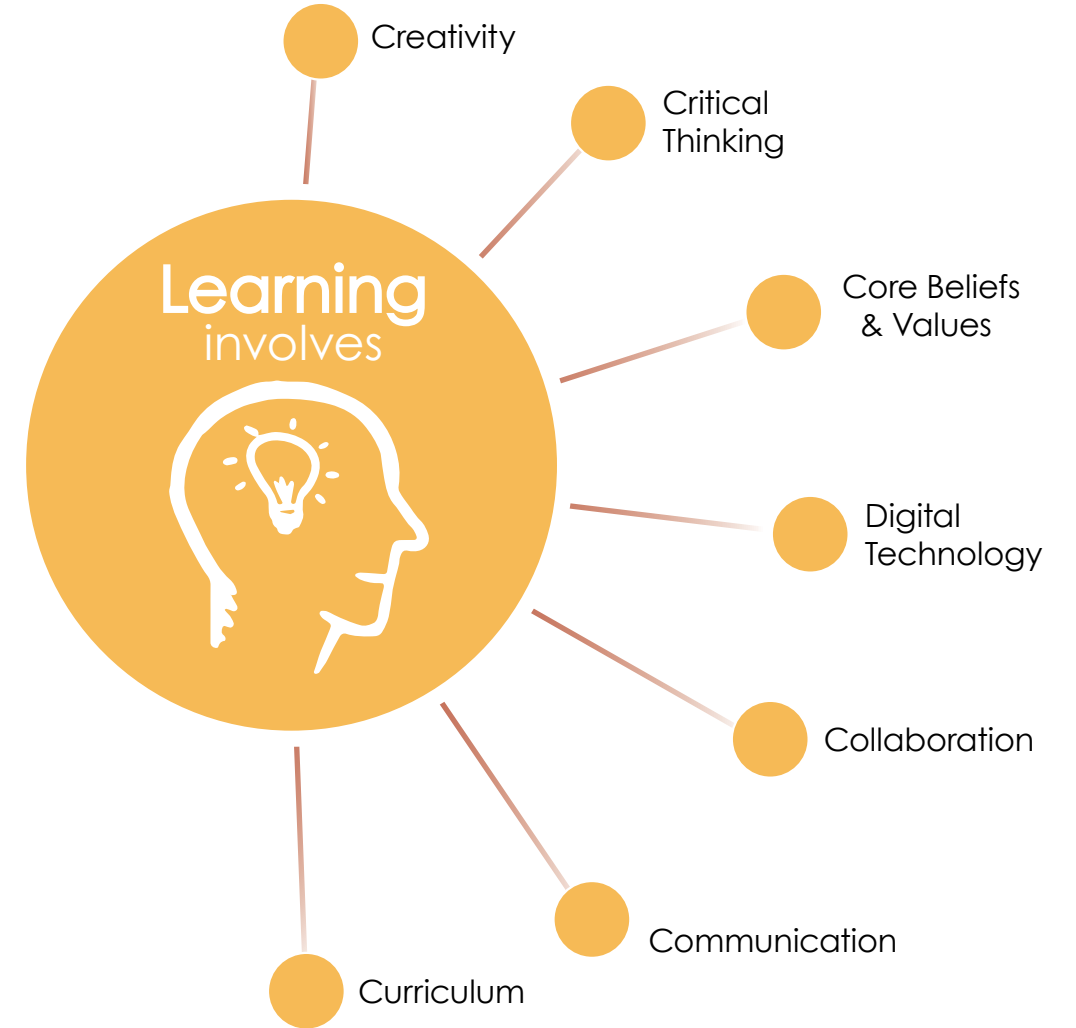
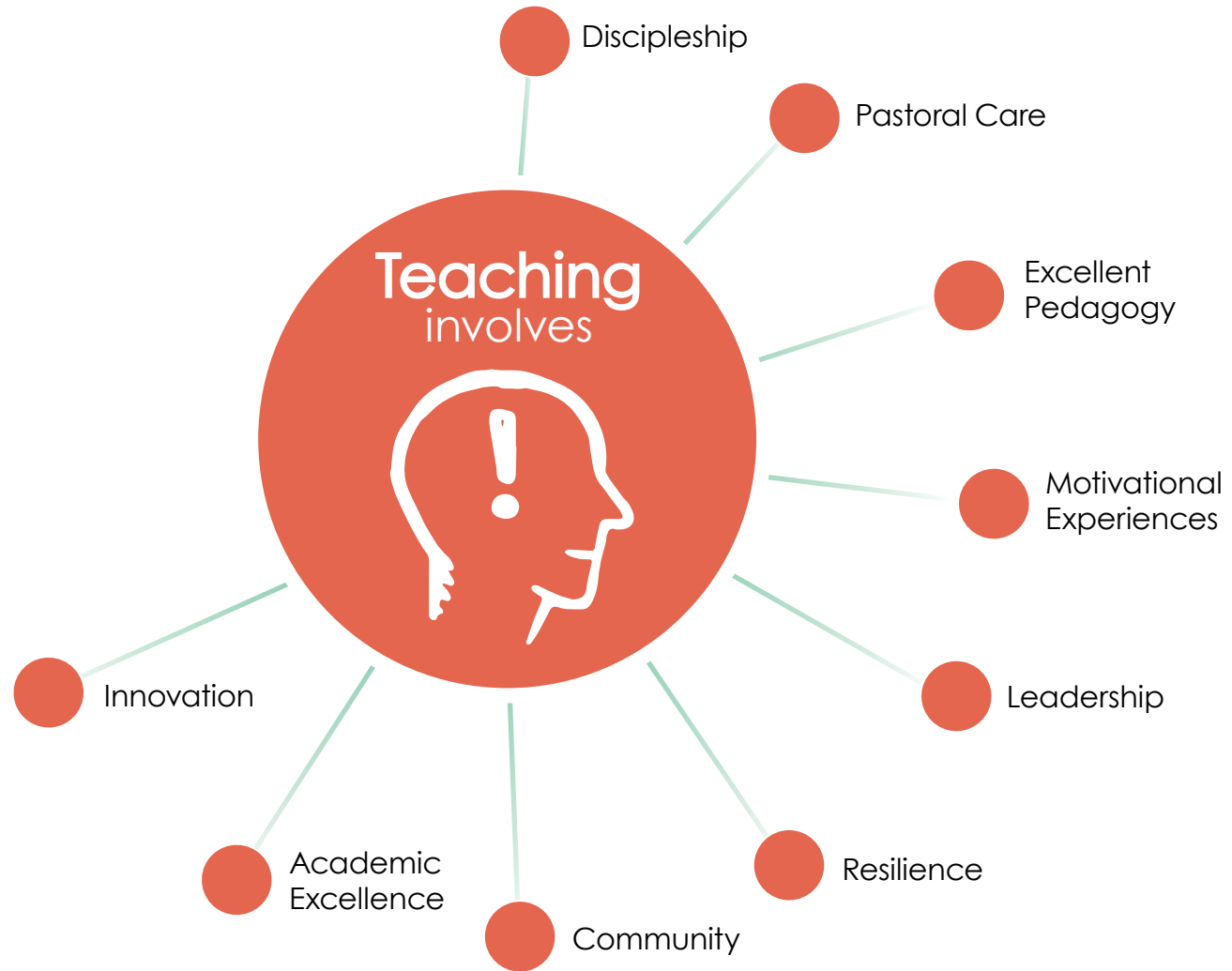
Mission and Strategic Objectives

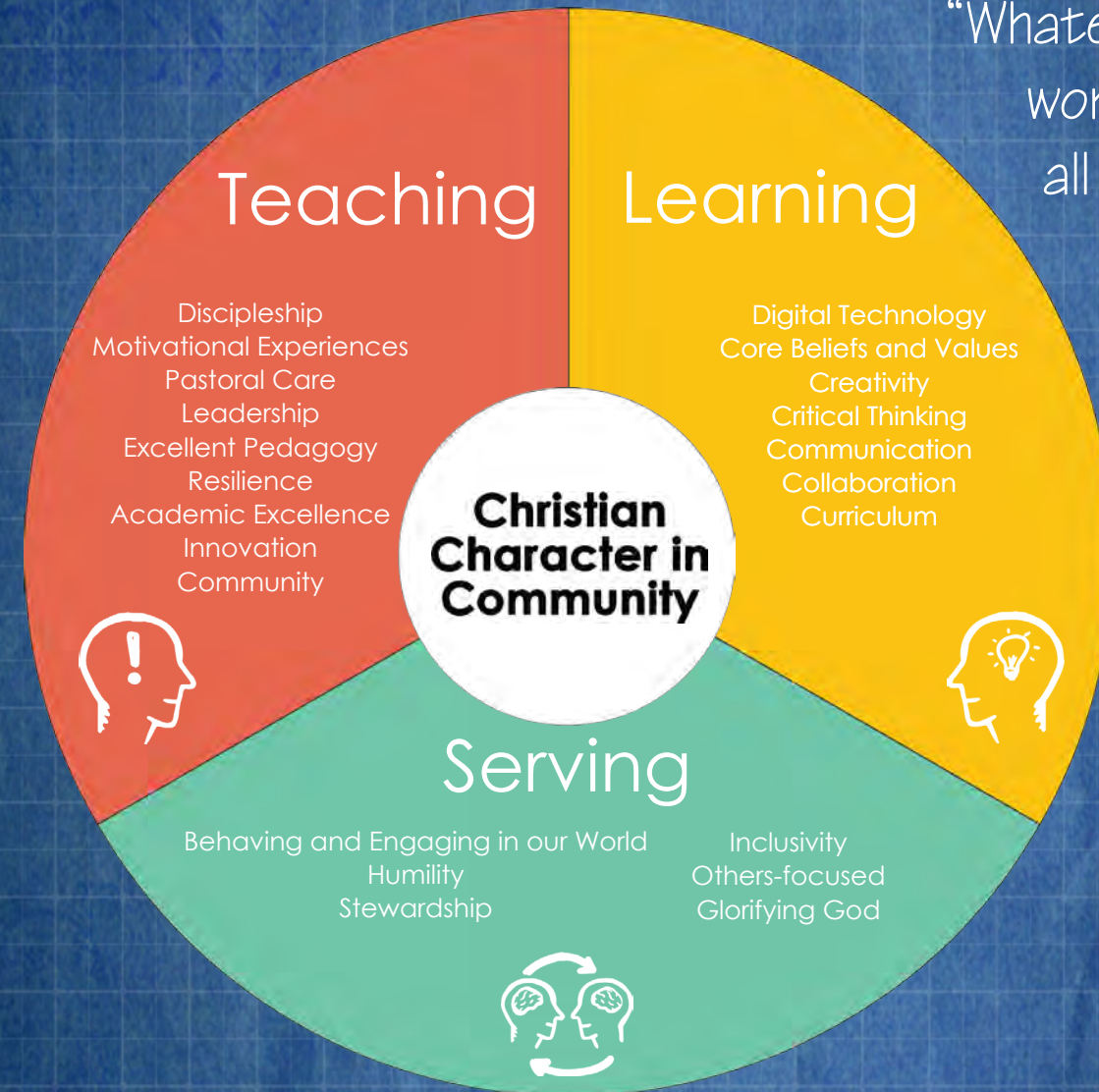
