

# TEC GAINS SELF-ACCREDITING REGISTRATION FOR STANDARD 6 (Proficient Level)

We are deeply pleased to be able to extend the service of TEC to its partner schools. The initial five courses that have been accredited have qualified us to be self-accrediting for Standard 6 ["Engage in Professional Learning"]. This means that for professional development courses that are focussed, for example, on 6.2.2. ["Participate in learning to update knowledge and practice targeted to professional needs and school and/or system priorities"], TEC can internally assess them for gaining NESA accredited professional development hours, at the proficient level.
