Responding to Diverse Cultural & Religious Backgrounds

Teaching for Problem Solving & Critical Thinking

Differentiation Strategies for ASD Students

Even though this course has a focus on ASD students, the principles of differentiation that are covered can be applied to any student situation requiring differentiation.

Managing Challenging Behaviour in the Classroom

Mentoring & Coaching

Data Informed Student Improvement

This course will help participants understand why Data Analysis is important for improving student achievement and learning and understand how having expertise in this area improves student learning in relation to NAPLAN data.

Using CANVAS to Improve Teaching (& Learning)
