

Leaders influence people. That's what leaders are designed to do. Christian Leaders have a very specific responsibility. That is to help people to grow in their relationship with God and be responsible disciples of Christ.

A leader's opinions have no more value or authority than anyone else's. It is vitally important that a Christian leader communicates content that is Biblical Grace and Truth in a way that reflects Biblical Grace and Truth.

How can we know this Grace and Truth that is Christ? Only through spiritual discipline.

Disciplines are things that we do, not just how we feel or even what we think. Spiritual Disciplines are active, consistent practices that inform our minds, our hearts and our actions

We are to "discipline ourselves for the purpose of Godliness." [1]

This is all the more critical for Christian Leaders whose task is to enhance the Christian community and lead others to know and reflect Christ.

The key foundation of all Spiritual Disciplines is the Bible. God has clearly revealed that His prime revelation is the person of Christ, who is revealed in the Scriptures.

All other Spiritual disciplines are founded upon the Scriptures and are informed by the Scriptures.

Now, if you are like me, discipline does not come easily! I struggle with the discipline of regular Bible reading. I seem to be easily distracted from starting to read; then easily distracted from continuing!

The solution is discipline. I discipline myself, not just to read the Bible and pray, but to want to grow in my relationship with God. For me, discipline has to involve some external pressure.

Firstly, I have a plan. My reading is not random. I set out to know what I can about the person of Jesus, the nature of the Father and the work of the Spirit in a particular book or letter.

Secondly, I read slowly and in natural length pieces. If I have 20 minutes of time, I only read for about ten minutes; then reflect on that passage for another ten minutes.

I find that the discipline of prayer then arises from my reading and reflection.

Another discipline that I experience, is because of what I'm called to do. I spend a lot of my time speaking with Christian Leaders, teacher groups, families and students. I am very aware that what I say must not be worldly opinion, but as Biblically accurate as possible. This weighty responsibility is upon all of us who are Christian leaders. It leads us to discipline ourselves for the purpose of Godliness. How do you engage with Spiritual Disciplines?
